Three \$2,000 scholarships to high school seniors who plan to attend college in the Fall of 2025 are available. The application is only available in digital form. ELIGIBILITY: Applicants must be High School Seniors of Hellenic descent who reside in Queens and attend a High School in any NYC borough, and who plan to attend a College or University in the Fall of 2025. (Exception: AHEPA members of Chapter 326, regardless of where they reside, whose qualifying children or grandchildren intend to attend a College or University in the Fall of 2025.) The winner of the scholarship awards will be awarded on "AHEPA" Sunday, June (DTBD), 2025. After Liturgy St. Nicholas Shrine Church, Flushing.

- In addition, the AHEPA Empire District No. 6 offers several scholarships to high school seniors who plan to attend college in the Fall of 2025. The first scholarship is for \$5,000, the second for \$3,000, the third and fourth are for \$1,500 and the fifth one is for \$1,000. In addition, \$1.000 has been allocated for an additional scholarship to a high school senior who will pursue a career in vocational training at an accredited school, i.e. health care, construction, manufacturing, carpentry, electronics, plumbing, etc. The AHEPA District 6 application and requirements are available online and may be easily downloaded at https://www.ahepad6.com/chapter-resources. The annual ceremony of the scholarship recipients will take place on June 7, 2025.

Scholarship awards may range up to a max of \$2,000, except where stipulated a different amount. The deadline is March 30, 2025. AEF, finally, offers the Constantine and Patricia Mavroyannis Scholarship for graduate students who are enrolled in a PhD program in either theoretical physics or physical chemistry in the Faculty of Science at a North American University. The scholarship is for \$5,000 and will be awarded in the Fall semester of 2025. The deadline for the Mavroyannis scholarship is June 2, 2025.
